- ◆ Always add water first, then the Shaklee product
- ◆ These products are concentrated....a little goes a long way
- ◆ There is always a “learning curve” when switching products so be patient and if you have questions as you use these products - please call the Shaklee Distributor who sold them to you to get the answer
- ◆ Use Shaklee spray & squeeze bottles...they are reusable cutting down on pollution
- ◆ Breathe easy....there are no harmful fumes in Shaklee cleaners Shaklee does not endorse the following recipes. These have been collected from people in the field from their experiences.

BASIC H

Reasons to Use Basic H

- ◆ Safe for plumbing
- ◆ Safe for marine life & vegetation
- ◆ Gentle - pH balanced (6.5)
- ◆ Does not hinder bacterial action of septic fields
- ◆ Non-volatile
- ◆ Non-irritating
- ◆ 100% organic
- ◆ Economical
- ◆ Anti-static, anti-magnetic
- ◆ Degreaser
- ◆ makes water wetter
- ◆ Non – hazardous & safe around children & pets
- ◆ Window spray 2-3 drops of Basic H /16 oz water
- ◆ General cleaner 1 tsp. Basic H / 16 oz water
- ◆ Cleaning solution 1-2 tsp. Basic H per gal of water
- ◆ Fine washables 1 tsp. of Basic H per sink full
- ◆ Dishes, add 1 tsp. of H to sink
- ◆ Dusting, dip sponge in solution of ½ tsp. of H in pint of water. Squeeze dry wipe off dust. Does not affect wax finish
- ◆ Floor cleaner, 1-2 tsp. H per gal of water
- ◆ Gum removal, apply Basic H directly, let sit, peel
- ◆ Spot remover/carpet, spray Basic H general cleaner, sprinkle with Nature Bright, scrub with brush, let dry & vacuum
- ◆ Eyeglass cleaner, 1 drop of H to 4 oz sprayer
- ◆ Silver polish, rub on H with cloth & rinse
- ◆ Jewelry cleaner, 1 tsp. H to ½ c water, let sit, rinse & dry
- ◆ Car wash, 1-2 tbs. of H/gal of water
- ◆ Stuck food in pans, squirt of H & fill pan with water. Bring to a boil and then let cool off
- ◆ Coffee pot cleaner, ½ tsp/pot -run thru; run through with plain water 3 times
- ◆ Outside windows, 1 tsp. of Basic H in “Ortho” sprayer for 2 gal of water. Spray on windows & screens. Squeegee dry.
- ◆ Leather cleaner, 2 drops of H on damp sponge. Clean & wipe dry
- ◆ Photos, to clean negatives, use 1 drop of H to qt of water
- ◆ Anti Static spray, Basic H General Household cleaner on clothes or in the dryer (6-7 times)...I also use it on my copier when the static becomes too strong
- ◆ House plants, 3-4 drops of H in 16 oz sprayer for house plant leaves. ½ tsp. per 16 oz water for routine watering
- ◆ Roses, 1 tbs. Basic H per gal for roses
- ◆ Awnings, 1 tbs. of Basic H per gal of water
- ◆ Static guard, use Basic H general household spray...in dryer or on clothes
- ◆ Weed Killer, 1-gallon Water ,1 tablespoon of Shaklee Basic H , ½ cup of white vinegar. Makes the best weed killer, and it is safe.
- ◆ Rinse Aid, in 4 oz bottle add ½ water & ½ Basic H and add to dishwasher dispenser
- ◆ Shoe cleaner, 2 drops of Basic H to wet cloth & clean

- ◆ Iron, add 2 drops of H in steam iron to keep jets clean or 2 drops to 4 oz of water and put in steam jets
- ◆ Soft soap, a few drops of Basic H to hands & wash
- ◆ Liquid Soap, mix ½ H with ½ water and fill pump dispense
- ◆ Shaving, apply full strength Basic H & lather with water
- ◆ Frying Vats, use ½ cup of H to 3 gal of water...boil for 5 in
- ◆ Diaper wipes, mix 1 ½ cup water, 1 tsp. H, 2 tbs. SW Baby Oil, 2 tbs. SW Shampoo. Put in a 1.6 quart container. Cut a roll of soft paper towels in half and put in the container. Remove core
- ◆ Camping, coat bottoms & sides of pans with H before placing over campfire
- ◆ Drip pans, use full strength H to coat drips pans...grime doesn't stick
- ◆ Knife sharpener, put a few drops on knife sharpener
- ◆ Boat algae, 1 tbs. per gal of water .
- ◆ Regular Pet Shampoo, ½ tbs. H to gal of water- not for cats
- ◆ Shampoo horses, 2 tbs. of H in 4 gal of water
- ◆ Fly spray for horses, 4 oz of H in 12 oz water...spray on
- ◆ Clean up in stables, use Basic H to wash buckets, tack etc/1 tbs. to gal of water
- ◆ Concrete & mortar Mix, ½ of per 1 gal of water makes cement & mortar spread easier & set harder
- ◆ Pressure Wash, 1 oz Basic H to 20 gal of water
- ◆ Laundry pre-spot, 4 tbs. L, 4 tbs. H, 2 tbs. I to sprayer of water
- ◆ Soften the water by adding 2-3 drops of H into your laundry tub
- ◆ Radiators....use 1 tbs. to radiator full of water or anti-freeze to prevent rust
- ◆ Dispose of Basic H water into your shrubs & lawn ...it will make them greener
- ◆ Humidifiers, use 3-4 drops of H in reservoir to prevent scum
- ◆ Greasy fans etc....apply H on a wet sponge; add more water as grease emulsifies & wipe clean
- ◆ Invisible Glove, before working on messy jobs, apply H directly to skin.... let dry
- ◆ Painting, add 1 tbs. of H to gal of paint. To clean brush, work straight H into bristles & rinse
- ◆ Golfers, 1 tsp. of H in 4 oz spray bottle, spray on clubs, balls etc. and brush clean. Good on golf gloves too
- ◆ Records, use window spray and clean with soft cloth
- ◆ Lawn fertilizer, 2 tbs. in "Ortho" sprayer per 1,000 sq. feet of lawn
- ◆ Fish odors, (or any odor), 1 tbs. of H to quart of water
- ◆ Toy Cleaner, 1-2 tsp. of H in gal of hot water
- ◆ Printer rollers, wipe on H to rubber rollers to restore life
- ◆ Poster Paint or "snow" removal, ½ tsp. of H in quart of water
- ◆ Pre-spot, H directly on clothes, activate with water and rub clean (great for vacations) Especially good on coffee, ink, lipstick, gum, grass, blood or ring around the collar.
- ◆ Crayon remover, straight Basic H to mark and wipe clean
- ◆ Skunk, onion or garlic smells, rub in full strength, rinse
- ◆ Wallpaper removal, 2 tbs to pail of hot water. Apply with sponge and lift off paper. Use 1 tbs./gal to remove paste
- ◆ Plant cleaner, spray leaves with Window cleaning solution to remove dust etc.

- ◆ Painting & Dyeing, Apply full strength H to hands & face before painting & dyeing....paint will wash off easily
- ◆ Car Engines, use ½ oz of Basic H to 1 gallon of water. Best results if engine is hot. Will not affect paint, gaskets, or insulating material.
- ◆ Battery terminals, Use ½ tsp. to pint of water...spray on battery terminals, let soak for 2 min. and clean with a wire brush. Use full strength Basic H on battery terminals to avoid corrosion or galvanic action.
- ◆ Car Wash (commercial), 1 quart of H to 100 gal of water
- ◆ Lipstick stains, full strength H on fabric, let soak, rub lightly & rinse clean
- ◆ Fresher flowers, add 8 drops to gallon of water instead of preservatives
- ◆ Candle Wax Remover, cover remains of wax in votive holder with water and add 1 tsp of H - let sit and wax pops out
- ◆ Do not use Basic H on anything you would not put water on like smooth leather or suede
 - *Do not mix Basic H with Basic G – Basic H will inactivate the germ killing ingredients in Basic G.*
 - *Due to EPA and FDA regulations we are not allowed to share with you recipes that many of us*
 - *use regularly (ie produce wash, minor burn relief, insect repellent, cradle cap, dandruff, cleaning*
 - *aquariums, rug and carpet shampoo, yard spray)*

BASIC I

Industrial strength you can trust

- ◆ No phosphates or nitrates
- ◆ Penetrates, emulsifies & removes grease & grime
- ◆ 1 quart makes 32 gallons of powerful cleaner
- ◆ Penetrates surfaces quickly & deeply
- ◆ Odorless & nonflammable
- ◆ Economical 26 cent a gal
- ◆ Safe for septic
- ◆ General cleaning 1 tsp. I in 16 oz water or 1 oz per gallon of water
- ◆ Super Mix 1 tbs. I with 2 tsp. of D and 16 oz of water
- ◆ Greasy jobs (BBQ grills) 2 oz (4 tbs.) I gallon of water. For extra cleaning power add 2 tbs. of Basic D
- ◆ Set stains use full strength Basic I (test color fastness)
- ◆ Battery terminals, 1 tsp. of Basic I in 16 oz sprayer...soak & rinse
- ◆ Oil on cement, 2 oz of I to gal of water plus ¼ c D or L
- ◆ Stainless steel, 2 tbs. of I in gal of water...soak & rinse
- ◆ Stoves/burners, 2 tbs. of Basic I & 1 tbs. D in hot water
- ◆ Pre-wash spray, fill a 16 oz sprayer with ¾ water, add 3-4 tbs. I. Great for ring around the collar, grease, grime, blood, grass
- ◆ Oven Cleaner, apply At Ease to oven surfaces. Spray with Pre-wash spray of I. Put steaming hot pan of water in oven and leave for 20 min.
- ◆ French Fryers, use ½ - 1 oz of I and fill with water...boil 30 min. and empty. Rinse clean
- ◆ Pre-spot for Laundry, full strength I on clothes (test for color fastness)...esp. good on whites (good on ink, ground in dirt & grass)
- ◆ “Bleach”, gallon container filled with water add 2 oz I & ½ cup D
- ◆ Paint Brushes, 2 tbs. of I in 2 quarts of hot water....soak clean

- ◆ Wonder Mix, 1 tbs. I, 1 tsp. of G in 16 oz sprayer...great for cleaning bathrooms & kitchens
- ◆ Battery Terminals, ½ tsp. of I to 4 oz spray bottle of water. Apply to terminals, soak & rinse. After cleaning, coat terminals with Basic H to lessen acid buildup
- ◆ Varnish remover, 2 tbs. I to gal of hot water, use with steel wool
- ◆ Oven cleaner, 1 tbs. I and 2 tsp. of D in sprayer of hot water...spray inside oven then scour with At Ease
- ◆ Oven racks, 2 oz of I to gal of water...add 2 tbs. of D if difficult
- ◆ Whitewall tires, dab on full strength I & scrub
- ◆ Patio furniture, 2 oz I and 2 oz of water...rub on and rinse off
- ◆ Wax stripper, 4 tbs. of I in gal of water...soak 10 min. & rinse
- ◆ Car engines & tools, 1 tbs. I and ¼ c L in gal of warm water. Warm engine and soak for 20 min.
- ◆ Heavy duty floor cleaner, 2 tbs. of I/gal of water. Can add 1 tbs. of D if really bad
- ◆ Wall cleaner, 4 tbs. of I per gal of water
- ◆ Drain Cleaner, 1 tbs. of I, ½ tbs. At Ease, 1 tbs. D...mix in ½ gal of hot water and pour down drain
- ◆ Oven cleaner, 1 tsp. I, 2 ½ tsp. L, ½ tsp. At Ease,...fill 4 oz squeeze bottle with hot water (¼ full) and add above ingredients. Spray on miracle pad and wipe down oven. Wait 10 min. and wipe clean
- ◆ Oven Cleaner, 1 tbs of At Ease & 1 tsp of Basic I in a bowl of water and beat till foamy. Heat oven to 150 degrees then turn off. Apply foam. Leave on for 15-20 minutes and then sponge off with warm water

- ◆ Litter box areas,...clean floor with 2 tbs. of G, ¼ c white vinegar in 1 gal of water
- ◆ Swimming pool decks....1 tbs. of G to 1 gal of water apply 2x week to keep bacteria and infections down

- ◆ Pre spotter 1 tsp. L & 1 tsp. of Nature Bright to 4 oz water or apply full strength
- ◆ Bleach use 1/8 cup of NB
- ◆ Add NB to toilet bowl & swish (“bleach”)
- ◆ STS fill sprayer with ½ water & ½ STS. Spray inside dryer 6-7 times before adding wet cloths
- ◆ STS mix 1-2 tbs. with quart of water and add to dispenser
- ◆ Use when washing out hosiery...STS will help prevent runs
- ◆ Soak the Impossible, 2 tbsp Nature Bright with 2 tbsp of Basic L. Put into a bucket and add hot water. Let stained item sit for 3 days. If, in the unlikely event that the stain is not gone, make a new batch and soak again.
- ◆ Anti-static add 2 oz of STS to 16 oz water (avoid upholstery) (it is now recommended that you do not make dryer sheets with STS –risk yellow spots on fabric)

- ◆ Smoky fireplace glass 1 tsp. of D to 16 oz water, spray, & wipe
- ◆ Car window 2 tbs. of D in 16 oz hot water
- ◆ Thermos stains add 1 tsp D and fill with hot water. 15 min scrub clean
- ◆ Hard water stains 2 tsp of D in toilet bowl & swish
- ◆ Burned pans sprinkle 1 tsp. on bottom of burnt pans..add hot water and soak overnight

In the Kitchen

- ◆ Coffee pot cleaner ½ tsp. H/pot run through & then run through with plain water
- ◆ Drip pans use full strength H to coat drip pans...food rinses right off
- ◆ Dishes add 1 tsp. of H to sink
- ◆ Rinse Aid in 4 oz bottle add ½ water & ½ Basic H and add to dishwasher dispenser
- ◆ Stuck food in pans squirt of H & fill pan with water. Let sit
- ◆ Kitchen fan filter soak in sink with 1 tbs. G, 1 tbs. I, 1-2 tbs. D
- ◆ Stoves/burners 2 tbs. I & 1 tbs. D in hot water
- ◆ Oven cleaner 1 tsp. of I, ½ tsp. L, ½ tsp. At Ease. Fill 4 oz squeeze bottle with hot water (¼ full) and add ingredients. Spray on Miracle Pad and wipe down oven. Wait 10 min. and wipe clean
- ◆ Oven cleaner 1 tbs. I and 2 tsp. of D in sprayer of hot water...spray inside oven then scour with At Ease
- ◆ Oven racks 2 oz of I to gal of water...add 2 tbs. of D if difficult
- ◆ Oven cleaner 1 tsp. I, 2 ½ tsp. L, ½ tsp. At Ease,...fill 4 oz squeeze bottle with hot water (¼ full) and add above ingredients. Spray on miracle pad and wipe down oven. Wait 10 min. and wipe clean
- ◆ Sink stains...spray bottom of sink with hot water and sprinkle D on, let sit, scrub & rinse
- ◆ Drain cleaner 1/8 c of G to 2 gal of water. Pour down drains & cover for 10 min. Pour tea kettle of boiling water down
- ◆ Fridge & freezer odors remove shelves & racks. Place in tub with hot water to cover and ½ c G. Clean the rest of the internal areas with 1 tbs. G, 2 tbs. white vinegar in quarter of water
- ◆ Garbage disposal deodorant ...make a tray of G ice cubes and run through ...2 tsp. of G in a pint of water...freeze....don't reuse trays for human consumption
- ◆ Sink stains...spray bottom of sink with hot water and sprinkle D on, let sit, scrub & rinse
- ◆ Frying Vats use ½ c of H to 3 gal of water, boil for 5 min.
- ◆ Oven Cleaner apply At Ease to oven surfaces. Spray with Pre-wash spray of I. Put steaming hot pan of water in oven and leave for 20 min.
- ◆ Knife sharpener put H on stone
- ◆ Garbage disposals 2 tsp. Biodegreat monthly
- ◆ When camping, coat bottoms of pans with Basic H before placing over campfire

- ◆ Drain cleaner 1 tbs. I, ½ tbs. At Ease, 1 tbs. D and mix in ½ gal of hot water, pour down drain

In the Bath

- ◆ Soft Soap mix ½ H with ½ water & fill dispenser or put a few drops of H to hands to wash
- ◆ Shaving apply full strength Basic H to face & lather up with water
- ◆ Grout & tile cleaner ¼ cup of D dissolved in hot water...brush on & rinse
- ◆ Diaper Wipes mix 1 & ½ cup water, 1 tsp. H, 2 tbs. SW Baby Oil, 2 tbs. SW Shampoo. Put in a 1.6 quart container. Add a roll of paper towels cut in half. Soak. Remove cardboard core.
- ◆ Shower Super cleaner 2 tbs. I, ½ tsp. At Ease, in 16 oz of water. Blend in blender. Wipe on, let sit and rinse off
- ◆ Biodegreat add to toilets routinely to keep functioning
- ◆ Toilet bowl cleaner 3-4 drops in toilet bowl & swish clean
- ◆ Clean bathroom with At Ease easily
- ◆ Sprinkle Nature Bright in toilet to help clean rust stains

In the Laundry

- ◆ Static guard use general household spray...in dryer or on clothes (also works on copier)

- ◆ Fine washables 1 tsp. per sinkful
- ◆ Pre-wash spray fill a 16 oz sprayer with ¾ water, add 3-4 tbs. I. great for ring around the collar, grease, grime, blood, grass
- ◆ Set stains...use full strength Basic I (test color fastness)
- ◆ Ring around the collar straight Liquid L
- ◆ Pre-spotter 1 tsp. L 1 tsp. of Nature Bright to 4 oz water or apply full strength
- ◆ "Bleach" use 1/8 cup of NB
- ◆ Dryer Spray fill sprayer with ½ water & ½ STS. Spray inside dryer 6-7 times before adding wet cloths
- ◆ Softer Than Soft mix 1-2 tbs. with quart of water and add to dispenser
- ◆ Use when washing out hosiery... Softer Than Soft will help prevent runs
- ◆ Laundry deodorizer 1 capful of G to laundry
- ◆ "Bleach" mix a gallon of water with 2 oz of I and ½ cup D

Automotive & Tool Specials

- ◆ Car wash 1-2 tbs. of H/gal of water
- ◆ Radiators....use 1 tbs. Basic H to radiator full of water or anti-freeze to prevent rust
- ◆ Whitewall tires apply full strength I and scrub
- ◆ Oil on cement 2 oz of I to gal of water plus ¼ c D or L
